



Simulate your “IRS” Discount

Every year, central government in Portugal transfers to municipalities the equivalent of 5% of the “IRS” charged locally. Municipal assemblies decide whether to keep these revenues or share them with taxpayers. Each council is able to forego between 0% and 5% (maximum) of the “IRS” that it receives from the State. For example, if the tax that you would normally pay is €2,500 and your town offers 4%, your discount will be €100, leaving a final assessment to pay of €2,400. Only those who actually pay tax receive this benefit. If you are owed a refund, it will be greater. If you have tax due, the levy will be less. This discount is automatic and does not involve any intervention on your part.
